TASK LIST

- 1. Install ceiling battens and plastering in hallway between entry foyer and the T-intersection.
- 2. Room 15 Check and fix minor water leak in ceiling space.
- 3. Finishing touches to Room 15.
- 4. Rooms 11, 12, 15 Caulking up gaps and fine sanding then paint.
- 5. Re-fasten some loose roofing iron sheets (replace loose nails with roofing screws).
- 6. Replace one stump at north corner of rear verandah under the ramp.
- 7. Exterior front wall apply No-More-Gaps, sand and paint.
- 8. Old timbers stored under house sort, stack and toss crap.
- 9. Room 13 window frame minor frame repair.
- 10. Kitchen spring clean and freshen.
- 11. Hedge (between driveway and building) needs either a trim or eradication (it provides camouflage for the local snake).
